McAuley Community Services for Women supports women and their children who are seeking safety from family violence by providing 24/7 crisis support and temporary accommodation.

### **McAuley Education Program**

Experiencing family violence can have a major impact on children's schooling, especially when they need to change schools. McAuley has developed an education program, delivered by volunteer tutors, to support children so there is not too much disruption and children don't fall behind at this time.

## Could you be a tutor?

We have exciting opportunities for volunteer tutors. The positions are for two to three hours per week, with the McAuley team who support women and children escaping family violence.

## We're looking for volunteers with:

- qualifications and/or experience in teaching or tutoring
- the ability to adapt to the needs of young people and encourage their engagement in education
- high level interpersonal communication skills
- reliability and availability to commit to a regular shift after school hours.

You will receive support and guidance from the McAuley team and will also have access to resources. You will have information from each child's school so that the tutoring can support the individual learning needs of children being supported.

## Other requirements

A National Police Check and Working with Children Check are required prior to commencement. A current driver's licence is desirable.
